AN EXPLANATION

Professional fees are set by the specialists and the settlement of those fees is the ultimate responsibility of the patient. Consultation fee levels are published and available to view and individual quotations are always provided for proposed treatments.

For patients choosing an insurer to indemnify costs, the benefit levels are set by the insurance company and the insurance contract is between the patient and their insurer. This applies also to provider or facility charges.

It is essential therefore that you confirm your level of cover for treatment as any difference between the professional fee and that allowed by your insurer is your responsibility.

For the first time, AXA PPP has published a benefit scale which reduces benefits to subscribers compared to their previous benefit levels.

This means that a shortfall is almost inevitable for AXA PPP patients and subscribers to this insurer are strongly urged to confirm their benefit entitlement and to take appropriate action.
